Waitsfield to hire administrator to spearhead FEMA help for Valley

The town of Waitsfield will take the lead to hire an administrator, serving flood victims in Waitsfield, Warren and Moretown. That administrator will act as a liaison between flood victims and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) which administers the various federal funds and relief agencies.

While that person is found, individuals and businesses that have suffered flood damage are urged to call FEMA at 1-800-462-9029 to get on the list of those in consideration for federal relief funds. With the Presidential declaration, proclaiming the Mad River Valley towns a federal disaster area, the towns become eligible for



Veterans benefits from the








Governor Howard Dean helicoptered into Warren on July 28.


