

Local Jurisdiction Request for Emergency Declaration

The Town of Waitsfield has suffered property damage and/or injury or loss of life from a disaster that exceeds our capability to respond to and recover from and that requires assistance from the State to protect the health, well-being, and public safety of our citizens. There, as provided in 20 V.S.A. Section 10, in my capacity as the Chair of the Waitsfield Selectboard, I request that the Governor declare a state of emergency for the Town of Waitsfield, Vermont.

This disaster began on Sunday, August 28, 2011. We have activated and utilized our Rapid Response Plan (RRP) or Emergency Operations Plan (EOP). I request that the State of Vermont activate and utilize its Emergency Operations Plan and authorize any resources needed to respond to, mitigate, and recover from this disaster. The Initial Local Emergency Disaster Situation Report will be sent to VEM as soon as it is completed; or The Initial Local Emergency Disaster Situation Report is attached to this Request.
