Bub was deeply dedicated to the community. He served 39 years on the Waitsfield-Fayston Volunteer Fire Department and 18 years on the Mad River Ambulance Service. Before he became Chief, he served as 2nd Assistant Chief for many years. Under his leadership, the department upgraded its gear to ensure firefighters’ safety, worked closely with the Water Commission on use of the new fire hydrants, was instrumental in achieving the reduced fire insurance rating through the ISO, and spearheaded the purchase of a new tanker pumper. He was also known for his shy humor, quick smile, and his artistry with wood. He was loved by the students and staff at the schools where he worked. He cared deeply about people and was willing to do what he could to make their lives better—always ready to help out. He will be very missed.
