21	Mr. Schwartz provided a presentation which outlined the information included in his written
22	update of April 12. He reviewed the reasons for initiating the project, the efforts and
23	accomplishments made so far, the current team structure for the work to be completed, and a
24	detailed project timeline covering 2022-2025.

26 27	3. Discussion. Mr. Weir outlined the potential funding sources for the project, most of the upcoming grant
28	applications will be for construction funding through both federal and state programs. Final
29	design work will also need to be funded, likely through the CWSRF.
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31	Ms. Peal and Mr. Anderson spoke of the coordination between this work and the bylaw update
32	effort that the PC is undertaking.
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34	Mr. Morris explained some of the proposed system's capacity details, noting that some planned
35	capacity is for replacing older systems, some for redevelopment of existing structures, and
36	some for completely new development. He also provided information regarding how phasing
37 38	of the project might unfold.
39	Mr. Voigt reminded the group that the forest block and wildlife habitat information that has
40	been incorporated into the Town Plan, including wildlife road crossings, needs to be considered
41	along with constraints such as wetland and river buffer areas.
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43	Mr. Anderson spoke of determining how operation and maintenance of a wastewater system
44	will be managed; Mr. Morris indicated that the firm who manages the water system may be
45	able to take this on.
